ELIBILITY

TEST LEVEL:

As of December 1, 2022, singles athletes may opt to accelerate their test progression within U.S. Figure Skating and thus compete at level(s) best suited for their technical skillset. Athletes must still meet the minimum requirements for each level and additionally, if participating within the National Qualifying Series (NQS) or National Excel Series (Excel), they will establish a **competitive floor** (i.e., the lowest level they can compete at).

The <u>competitive floor</u> is determined only by the level selected through the EMS Series Application for NQS or Excel and is not uniquely tied to competition registration (regardless of series participation).

Example, if an athlete passed their junior free skate test in November and competed in the 2022-23 NQS as a Novice from July - September, they may register for either novice or junior in excel or well-balanced events. The novice level will remain their competitive floor until they complete an EMS Series Application at the junior level or higher for NQS or Excel.

Example #2, if an athlete passed their juvenile free skate but has not competed in NQS or Excel (i.e., they have not established a competitive floor), they have the option to compete pre-preliminary – intermediate (if skate up is permitted). While the options are wide, U.S. Figure Skating entrusts the coach to guide the athlete to the select the appropriate level for the athlete based on their technical skillset.

Eligibility Notes:

- 1. The singles free skate test levels will remain as a minimum requirement to compete.
- 2. Athletes may not skate down in any event.
- 3. This update does NOT apply to Adult, Showcase and Solo Dance.

The competition will be held at **Holiday Twin Rinks, 3465 Broadway, Cheektowaga, New York** (a suburb of Buffalo). Events will be conducted on a 85' x 200' rink. Snack bar and dressing rooms are available. Directions to the rink are available at: www.holidayrinks.com.

ADMISSION

Admission to all events is free.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are as follows:

\$75.00 for first event \$130 for IJS \$40 for Compete USA events

DEADLINE

The online registration deadline is midnight of April 1, 2023, **OR WHEN THE MAXIMUM CAPACITY OF 300 SKATERS HAS BEEN REACHED**. If space permits, applications **may** be accepted after this date with the chairperson's approval only and a \$25 LATE FEE WILL BE ASSESSED.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT (PPC) SUBMISSION/UPLOAD - FOR IJS EVENTS ONLY:

EMS PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT (PPC) – Competitors participating in IJS events are required to submit PPC in EMS no later than **April 15th 11:59PM**. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature in EMS and subject to a **\$15 late fee**. The late fee will automatically be added to each skater's cart who doesn't meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to receiving the skater credential onsite.

REFUND POLICY

No refunds will be issued after the close of entries unless the event has been cancelled (Rule 3048). There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals.

REGISTRATION

A registration desk will be located at the main entrance to Holiday Twin Rinks and will be open throughout the competition. Competitors should register promptly upon their arrival. Music should be downloaded no later than April 15th, 2023.

NOTE: Skaters must be at the rink – and **READY TO SKATE** - at least **1 HOUR BEFORE** their scheduled event time. Events will not be delayed for late arriving skaters. This is a non-qualifying competition and events may run ahead or behind schedule.

AWARDS

Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th and 5th places. Awards will be available immediately after the event has been posted and can be picked up at the awards table.

MUSIC

EMS MUSIC UPLOAD: Competitors participating in events with music are required to upload their music to EMS no later than April 15th, 2023 @ 11.59pm. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature and subject to a **\$15** late fee. The late fee will automatically be added to each skater's cart who doesn't meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to receiving the skater credential onsite.

Competitors must also bring a copy of their competition music on digital copy (phone, ipod, or jump drive) as a backup in case of technical difficulties and must be available rink side during the competition.

RESULTS

Results will be available at the registration event after each event for \$0.25 per copy for 6.0 events, \$1.00 for IJS.

SCHEDULE

As soon as possible after the entry deadline, a TENTATIVE SCHEDULE will be posted on the Skating Club of Western New York web site: www.skatingclubofwesternnewyork.org. No schedule times will be given out over the phone.

VIDEO/CAMERA

Personal videotaping may only be done from the stands with hand held cameras. No lights, tripods or taping permitted at rink side. For the safety of the skater – NO FLASH PHOTOGRAHY WILL BE PERMITTED.

LOCKER ROOMS & CHANGING AREAS:

Locker Rooms will be available at this event for skate tying only, doors must be kept open at all times.

PRACTICE

Practice ice will be available on Saturday, May 20th and Sunday, May 21st at 7:00 a.m. There will be 2 – 25 minute practice ice sessions available at a cost of \$15.00 per session. One session will be for No-Test through Pre-Juvenile and one session will be for Juvenile through Adult. No music will be played during practice ice.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL COACHES:

To be a credentialed coach at a sanctioned nonqualifying competition, coaches must meet the following requirements: Coaching U.S. Figure Skating athletes:

- Current member in good standing with U.S. Figure Skating
- Completed background check (green light status)
- Completed SafeSport Training*
- Continuing Education Requirements (CERs) for the 2022-23 Competition Season
- Proof of current general liability insurance with limits of \$1 million per occurrence/\$5 million aggregate.

Coaching Compete USA athletes:

- Learn to Skate USA Instructor membership OR U.S. Figure Skating full membership
- Completed SafeSport Training* (for coaches 18 years old and over)
- Completed background check (green light status) (for coaches 18 years old and over)
- Learn to Skate USA Instructor Certification completed (for coaches under 18 years old)

*SafeSport training is available through <u>www.usfsaonline.org</u> for full members of U.S. Figure Skating (through Learn to Skate USA portal for instructors). There is no cost to this training and certification is valid for 2 seasons.

The LOC will have a list of compliant coaches who are approved to receive a credential at the competition. Coaches will need to check in at the event registration desk and show a government issued photo I.D. to receive a credential.

If a coach cannot provide a photo I.D. and is not on the list or cannot produce the necessary documents, he or she will not be allowed a credential. There can be no exceptions to this policy.

If a foreign coach has only foreign athletes at your competition, a background check and SafeSport Training is not required. Instead, the coach must submit a letter from their Federation stating they are a member in good standing.
