

GENERAL RULES

- Skaters must check in for each session with the Ice Manager. If you are using an Ice Card
 please have the card with you when checking in. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Skaters should avoid interrupting skaters who are in a lesson. Never talk to a professional during another skater's lesson; you will appreciate the same consideration when you are having a lesson.
- There should be no standing around or talking at the boards. Do not socialize in groups in the corners.
- Skaters heard using profanity or engaging in improper behavior will be ejected from the session.
- 5. During dance time, free skating and moves-in-the-field are not allowed unless you are in a lesson. Dance time is only for skater's that are currently working on dance.
- 6. Do not race, play tag, or practice hockey techniques.
- 7. Music must be turned in to the music player upstairs. Music will be put in order according to when it was turned in. Professionals can have a skater's music played out of order when they are in a lesson only.
- 8. The skater whose music is being played has the right-of-way. Other skater's must make every effort to stay out of that skater's way.
- 9. Be courteous and positive with your fellow skaters and parents.
- 10. Clean up your tissues, cups and other items left on the boards.
- Skaters should exit the ice at the end of their sessions. For everyone's safety, no one should be on the ice when the Zamboni is out.
- 12. If you have a question or concern with the policies and procedures of the SCWNY, please see a Board Member for assistance. The club will not tolerate any character defamation or threats made to any member of the club.
